**CROSSRAIL WEST PROJECT UPDATE AND THE USE OF BIM**

Taylor Woodrow are currently delivering the £150M Western section of the Crossrail route on the existing National Rail Network. The Project is currently increasing Stations facilities, constructing longer platforms modified canopies, footbridges, lift and stair arrangements to accommodate the operation of the new 10-car Crossrail trains. Andrew will give a Project Overview before introducing other team members to focus on how the Project is using BIM in the integration of the Multidiscipline designs and using 4D BIM to plan the works.
