Applications will be reviewed against the following criteria

Ordinary membership of the RCEA shall be accorded to those who are engaged in, or have been engaged in, the development, design, construction or maintenance of engineering infrastructure for railway operations. Ordinary members will normally be professional engineers. Membership may also be accorded on the basis of experience, position of responsibility, or contribution to the railway infrastructure industry.

Young Professional Members shall normally be engineering graduates on a formal training scheme, who have an enthusiasm and interest in railway civil engineering. Graduates not on a formal training scheme will be accepted if they supply an acceptable statement explaining how they intend to gain suitable structured experience. Young Professional Members shall transfer to the grade of Ordinary Member upon becoming a Chartered Engineer or after five years, whichever is the sooner.
